Proposal in respect of closing the F.S. Macey Fund.

The FS Macey fund was set up with a bequest from FS Macey for the purpose of providing books to the Maidstone district to aid in learning, this to be extended to the County where possible. Over the years this fund has dwindled and now the County committee feel it is of a value that is not worth maintaining any longer and the Maidstone District has received a cheque from the County Treasurer for the sum of £81.36 representing the remainder of the FS Macey fund.

A discussion was had at the last Maidstone District Committee meeting to consider how best to use up this money.

What we propose is to invite all towers within the Maidstone District to apply for books from the District Bookshop that would be of use to their tower and ringers. The District Committee will take these requests on a "first come, first served" basis and consider each reasonable request on its own merit.

Please write or e-mail to the District secretary, verbal requests will not be taken, the date the secretary receives your request being the date used for placing these requests in order. Any books given out will be reported at the next and subsequent quarterly meetings until the fund has been used up.
