# **Minutes**

For the Quarterly District Meeting held on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> January 2017 at Yalding.

# 2017/QMA02 Minutes and any matters arising from previous meeting: -

a) 2016/ADM Staplehurst 8<sup>th</sup> October 2016 Staplehurst

The minutes were agreed signed by the Chairman.

#### Matters arising:

- Attendance of 25+ members at District events is common. Barry Evans was thanked for organising the refreshments at the 2016 carol service. Calendar for 2017/18 – suggestions from the membership are invited for a District event in August.
- The treasurer's report has now been updated to the end of 2016.
   Membership is stable, but junior membership is declining: 6 in 2016, down from 15 in 2015.
- 3.) Daniel Brady provided an update on the creation of a KCACR mobile ring. Potential contribution(s) in kind would reduce the overall cost to £5,000 (from ~£7,000). 31 responses to the survey received to date, conveying very mixed views. - 4.) The Chairman said that all towers should have received an e-mail from Tom Winter, the new KCACR training officer, requesting information about the teaching facilities available at each tower with the possibility of holding county-level training sessions. Within Maidstone District, training requests can also be made to the two Ringing Masters.
- 5.) Daniel Brady said that Maidstone District will be hosting the county 6-bell striking competition on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> September. Suggestions for a suitable tower were invited from the membership.
